**BEING A BY – LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATING OF
VEHICLE PARKING DURING THE CLEANING, SNOW REMOVAL
AND SNOW PLOUGHING SEASON FOR THE YEAR 2018**

PARKING REGULATIONS – HIGHWAY & STREET CLEANING


No person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked on a highway and/or street:

1. So as to interfere, in any manner, with the work of clearing and / or removing snow or ice there from, or
2. In such a manner so as to interfere with highway or street cleaning operations, or
3. Between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. from the 1st day of November to the 31st day of March in any calendar year (for the purposes of snow removal)
4. In the event that a vehicle is found in contravention of this section, a Police Officer or By – Law Enforcement Officer or Road Supervisor, may take or cause such vehicle to be taken to and stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removal, care and storage thereof shall be alien upon such vehicle and be payable before the surrender of such vehicle, as provided in the Repair and Storage Liens Act R.S.O. 1990, C R 25.

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow, ice or other debris to any highway, street, sidewalk or boulevard within the municipality.

Every owner or occupant shall ensure that any snow, ice or debris is removed immediately. Any snow, ice or debris may be cleared at the direction of the Superintendent of Public Works without notice and at the expense of the owner of the land and such costs may be recovered by action or by adding the costs top the roll and collecting them in the same manner as municipal taxes.
