

Earlton Pool Rules

If you have symptoms of COVID-19, feeling unwell or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, please stay home.

1. Arrive ready to go swimming, you cannot change in the changerooms. You are guaranteed 30 minutes of swim time.
2. Enter through North side door.
3. Upon arrival you will have to sanitize your hands, provide your name, answer screening questions.
4. If you don't have a swim pass you will be required to pay, please bring exact change (\$3 per person)
5. Swim passes will be available for purchase
6. You MUST follow the arrows
7. You MUST shower
8. You will be assigned a designated area; You MUST put your towel and shoes on the table/bench in your designated area.
9. You MUST remain in your designated area. You MUST keep physically distanced from people in other zones.
10. Restrooms are available through the exit. You must shower to re-enter.
11. No spitting, blowing of nose or polluting the water in any way
12. Food is NOT allowed
13. Pool toys are NOT allowed.
14. You can bring goggles and a plastic water bottle.
15. If you need a lifejacket, ask a lifeguard

If you cannot follow the rules your pass will be revoked and no refund will be issued, let's work together.

Standard Earlton Swimming Pool Policy

All persons/bathers who visit the Township of Armstrong swimming pool do so at their own risk. The Township of Armstrong swimming pool facility and employees do not accept responsibility for any injury or accident to any individuals while at the Township of Armstrong Swimming pool. The Township of Armstrong is not responsible for any theft, lost or damaged articles - all personal belongings are the responsibility of the individual. There are inherent risks involved in any activity; individuals participating in activities at the Township of Armstrong swimming pool wishes to advise individuals that they are responsible for any and all costs arising out of injury or property damage sustained through participation. Should someone become injured while at the Township of Armstrong swimming pool, they are to notify a lifeguard on duty immediately.

The Township of Armstrong employees reserve the right to request individuals to leave the premises immediately if they fail to follow The Township of Armstrong swimming pool rules and regulations, procedures, posted signage or engage in inappropriate behaviour. Individuals engaging in inappropriate behaviour, or whose conduct does not conform to rules and regulations will be asked to leave the premises and, depending on the severity of the conduct, may be temporarily or permanently banned from the premises as per our discipline policy. Suspension of such privileges shall not entitle participants to a refund.

- Individuals must be courteous to all staff, participants, guests or others while on the premises. Use of obscene, profane, vulgar, derogatory, demeaning, or threatening language and/or gestures, will not be

tolerated and will be handled according to the facilities discipline policy and may be reported immediately to appropriate authorities.

- Vandalism and damage to the Township of Armstrong Swimming pool property or the personal property of others will not be tolerated. Individuals responsible for these actions will be reported to authorities and liable to prosecution.
- Theft is a serious violation of the law and will be dealt with accordingly. The Police will be notified immediately of any patrons caught in the act of theft, and offenders will be immediately removed from the facility. If the offender is under the age of 18 years, the Township of Armstrong will attempt to notify the parent/guardian. All incidents of theft will be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the criminal code the Township of Armstrong will determine if the offender(s) will be banned from facilities.
- The Township of Armstrong reserves the right to request appropriate identification from any individual entering the facilities. Individuals who refuse to provide identification may be asked to leave the premises.
- The Township of Armstrong employees reserve the right to question any suspicious behaviour or activity. Failure to co-operate with staff may result in suspension of the individual's activities or immediate removal from the premises.
- Loitering is not permitted anywhere on the premises. Once use of the facilities and its services is completed, patrons should leave the premises. Prolonged observation of patrons by individuals who have no direct relationship with these patrons is considered loitering and may be viewed as a violation of personal privacy.
- The use of cell phones, cameras and other video equipment is not permitted in restricted areas such as the change rooms and pool deck.
- In accordance with Smoke Free Environment Act smoking/vaping is prohibited within children's playgrounds or public areas (public swimming pool) within 20 meters of children's playgrounds.

Discipline Policy

- First Offence: First Verbal Warning
- Second Offence: Second Verbal Warning/Reminder that suspension of privilege is next.
- Third Offence: Suspension of privilege for 1 day
- Fourth Offence: Suspension of privilege for 1 week
- Fifth Offence: Suspension of privilege for summer

For instances of theft or vandalism:

- Suspension of privilege for the summer, no refund issued
- If person is under 18, a telephone call to the parent/guardian will be placed
- A call to the local authorities
