



For Immediate Release Earlton Recreation Centre

As of Wednesday, September 22, 2021 the Government of Ontario has released Regulations and requires patrons who are 12 years of age and older, visiting the Earlton Recreation Centre to show identification and proof of full vaccination or medical exemption.

The second dose must be administered at least 14 days prior to your visit.

This will be required every time an individual enters the facility to access the gym, events and includes hall rentals; both private and public. Staff will be screening patrons.

Valid forms of identification must be an original and will show the full name and birthdate (i.e health card, birth certificate, or passport) along with a valid vaccination slip or picture of the slip.

Patrons can provide proof of immunization by downloading or printing their vaccine receipt from the provincial booking portal at <https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/>

The gym is no longer available 24 hours.
