Recreation/Landfill Labourer (Full-Time – Contract)

Reporting to the Public Works Superintendent, the Recreation/Landfill Labourer will assist with general maintenance of recreation facilities, parks, and the landfill site. This role includes duties such as basic groundskeeping, arena cleaning, and overseeing landfill operations.
